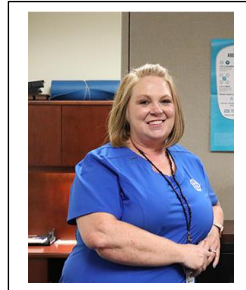

Dr. Burnette will present the State of Sexual Assault at November Luncheon

Make your reservation today to hear **Dr. Cindy Burnette**, manager of the Texas Health Resources System's Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner program, update us on the current state of sexual assault in Johnson County at our regular membership luncheon. We'll meet on **Tuesday, November 19** (meeting date changed to avoid a conflict with Thanksgiving) at the JCRP Headquarters, 210 S. Main in Cleburne. Networking will begin at 11:30 a.m. with the program starting at Noon. Cost is \$15 per person. Email your RSVP to President Tiffany Strother at tiffany@strotherandstrotherlaw.com by November 15.

After starting her practice in emergency nursing and trauma, Dr. Burnette gained certification through the Texas Office of the Attorney General (OAG) as a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) and through the American College of Forensic Examiners Institute as a Certified Forensic Nurse (CFN).

She has seven years of forensic nursing experience to include more than 150 completed sexual assault medical forensic examinations of both the pediatric and adolescent/adult population. These sexual assault medical forensic examinations have also led to numerous courtroom testimonies in the Texas court system. Dr. Burnette was the SANE Coordinator for Medical Center Hospital in Odessa before joining Texas Health Resources System SANE Services in 2016. She currently manages the program for the southwest region of DFW for seven THR hospitals.

Members and guests are encouraged to bring NEW pajama pants, tops, yoga pants, underwear, socks, shirts (of all sizes) or gift cards to be donated to Texas Health Resources to provide clothing for female assault victims. Following medical exams and having their clothing become physical evidence these women only have paper scrubs to wear away from the hospital. Let's help them leave the hospital with dignity.

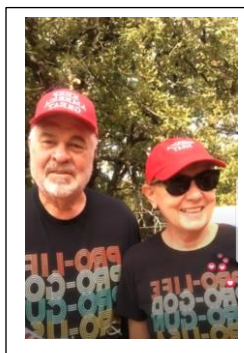
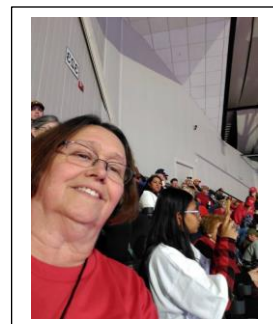
